RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT POLICY AND PROCEDURES

Medaille College has student success at its highest priority and recognizes the connection between on-campus living and persistence to graduation. It is the policy of the College that all freshman and sophomore students who do not reside with their parents or legal guardians (within a 50 mile radius) are required to live in College owned housing. Freshman and sophomore students whose parents or legal guardians live beyond a 50 mile radius are required to live in College owned housing.

Exemption from the Residency Requirement may be granted to students who are: married, single parents, veterans, or 21 years of age or older. Students seeking exemption from the policy must submit the *Request for exemption from Required Housing Policy form,* including necessary documentation, to the Office of Residence Life for review and approval by the Director of Residence Life and Student Conduct or their designee.

If your reason is denied, and you fail to pay your deposit and fill out an application, the Office of Residence Life will assign you to a Residence hall room and charges will be added to your student bill.
